
Privigen® 10g and 40g Sizes Available

Dear Colleagues:

Customer letter [CL 2020-06](#) communicated that additional supplies of Privigen® were procured to relieve pressure on other intravenous immune globulin brands (IVIg), especially Gammagard Liquid®. This situation is a result of a misalignment between product specific demand and supply, where Gammagard Liquid® is still being ordered above the planned share splits and not due to a supply shortage.

To encourage additional use of Privigen®, both **10g and 40g** sizes are being re-introduced to the plasma protein products formulary. With these additions, Canadian Blood Services will now carry five different vial sizes of Privigen® 2.5g, 5g, 10g, 20g and 40g.

Privigen® 2.5g, 5g, and 20g vial sizes are readily available. Customers may place orders for Privigen® 10g and 40g starting week of July 27th, 2020.

The addition of Privigen® is not temporary and is planned to be in place for the duration of the current supplier contracts. We encourage our hospital customers to proactively and collaboratively work with us to ensure that future demand for different Ig brands is aligned with supply. We are asking hospital customers who are increasing their use of Privigen® to contact their local hospital liaison specialist with your hospital's planned percent changes, as this will help us forecast demand.

The following table shows the supply share splits that are currently projected to be available.


